**Introduction to the Liturgy:** Today's reading from Ecclesiastes and today's Gospel from Luke each feature a wealthy and successful individual. The rich man in Jesus' parable thinks he is all set for life, but he is about to get a most unpleasant surprise. At least the character in the first reading realizes he can't take it with him, but this doesn't leave him any happier. St Paul's words of advice to the Colossians point to an alternative: 'Look for the things that are in heaven.' As we listen to the readings today, let us think of how we should do this.
